## HIGHLIGHTS IN THE COMMUNITY

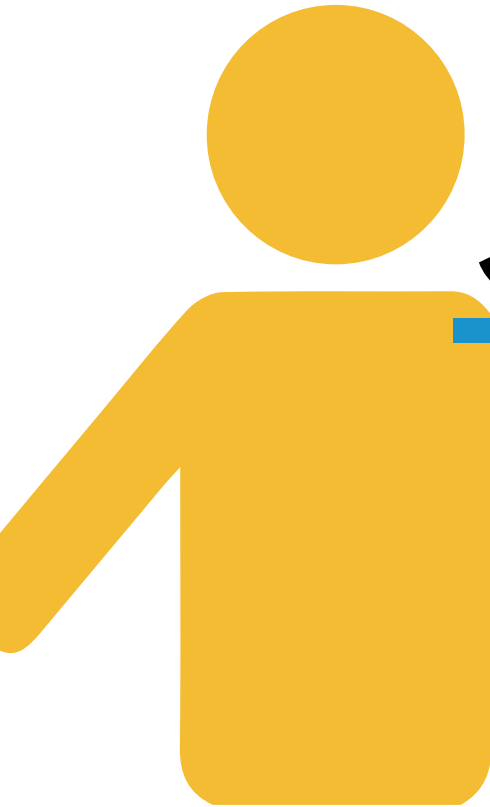
